The fertile valleys of the Mendoza Andean foothills provide a great habitat for deer that have developed impressive racks, with some reaching the 400 SCI+ class, a size typically only found in ranches in New Zealand and Europe.

THE HUNTING

- Tupungato is bow hunting friendly
- Available game: Red Stag, Fallow Deer, & Wild European Boar
- Hunts depart before dawn
- Horses, ATVs, and 4x4s are used to access hunting areas
- Drives vary, but typically range from 15-45 minutes
- Private guides and English-speaking staff
- Horseback drives escorted by gaucho
- Evening hunts last until dark

This exclusive preserve spans 20,000 acres and sits high on the property with views of the highest peaks in the Andes. On the lower grounds, the family owns a working vineyard. This lodge can accommodate 8 guests (4 hunters and 4 non-hunters).
